Wedding Information Form

If We Are To Proceed:

- ___ Either the bride or groom must be baptized
- ___ Both parties must freely and knowingly consent to be married
- ___ Both must accept that Holy Matrimony is a physical and spiritual union entered into within a community of faith
- ___ Both parties are expected to be regular worshipping members of St. Francis, which means one of the following:
 - a) one or both already members, or
 - b) a desire and commitment to become members, including regular attendance at worship for at least 3 mo prior to wedding
- ___ Consent to instruction in the nature, meaning, and purpose of Holy Matrimony (approximately 6 sessions, beginning at least 3 mo prior to wedding)
- ___ If previously divorced:
 - ___ Marriage must be a minimum of 6 months after date of divorce decree, and
 - ___ The bishop must consent to remarriage (*submit form 60 days prior to wedding date*)
- ___ Have either of you consulted with any other clergy with regards to being married? If so, what parish, response: _____
